[New Windows DLL Naming]

- Before:
 - Static Libs:
 - tine.lib (single threaded)
 - tinemt.lib (multi-threaded)
 - Dynamic Libs:
 - tine32.dll (single threaded)
 - tine32mt.dll (multi-threaded)
 - Secondary dependencies on tine32mt.dll

[New Windows DLL Naming]

- After:

- Static Libs:

- tine.lib (single threaded)
- tinemt.lib (multi-threaded)

- Dynamic Libs:

- tine.dll (single threaded)
- tinemt.dll (multi-threaded)
- tine32.dll (canonical) -> tinemt.dll
- Secondary dependencies on tine32.dll
 - Windows apps should always link to tine32.dll (tine32.lib)

[Latest Deployments]

- cdi32.dll now makes use of long names
 - cdi device name up to 32 characters
 - cdi template : 16 chars
 - cdi template field 16 chars
 - TODO: make use of BITFIELDS
- Instant Client now queries for NAME64 device names and NAME64 property names; NAME32 contexts, NAME32 device server names

[Some New Stock Properties]

- “SRVBINFILE”
 - Reads/writes binary file (analogous to “SRVLOGFILE”)
 - TODO: Read section of file (offset + length)
- “SRVINIT” (analogous to “SRVEXIT”)
 - Calls equipment module’s init function (if allowed)
- “SRVRESET”
 - Clears mutexes, semaphores, connection table entries, calls equipment modules init functions
